(A reflection from the previous week's sermon):

In Exodus 11 & 12 (The Passover) we see two parallels to our redemption story: The certainty of death and a sacrificial lamb. Death came to the homes where the sacrificial blood was not applied. Jesus is the perfect, spotless Passover Lamb! Because of His blood applied (if we repent and believe) we are alive spiritually and invited to partake of the bread (His body) and the cup (His blood).
